2016-2017 HOME GR/OWN Strategy


- HOME GR/OWN converted 20 vacant lots into pocket parks and community orchards in 2015
- 2016 and 2017 strategy: target vacant lot beautification primarily on North Avenue
- With Zilber grant, ECO, DCD and DPW are beautifying North Avenue from 8th to 27th
- Goals are to:
 - Enhance development potential in commercial corridors
 - Improve pedestrian and biker experience
 - Improve commuters' perception of Milwaukee.
- Landscaping and "light touch" beautification to preserve potential for commercial development on vacant lots.






