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## 2007 Resident Preference Program Report

#### **Executive Summary:**

Section 309-41 of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances requires that the Department of Public Works submit an Annual Report to the Common Council summarizing the results of activities of the Resident Preference Program (RPP) of the previous year.

The ordinance requires that 25 percent of worker hours be performed by unemployed residents of the special impact area except in special cases where the Commissioner of Public Works determines there is sufficient reason to impose lesser levels of participation. The designated target area district corresponds to the City's Community Development Block Grant Area.

This report contains several exhibits each illustrating a certain aspect of the programs performance.

Exhibit A is a summary of the year 2007 activities as it pertains to the RPP. Most importantly, the average target resident participation rate for 2007 contracts that have been closed to date is 30.5%. Meaning, nearly one-third of the work on DPW contracts is being fulfilled by target residents. Another significant number is the percentage of contracts that did not require target resident participation, which is less than 10% for two consecutive years. Only 13 of the 133 DPW contracts (9.7%) did not require work from a target resident population. DPW makes every effort to require 25% RPP in as many construction contracts as possible. In all cases where DPW does not require any resident worker participation, it is either on specialty projects where potential bidders are not local contractors and typically do not have local employees on staff, or funding sources such as Wisconsin Department of Transportation that do not permit this requirement. A more detailed explanation is included in this report in a section titled Contracts Requiring less than 25% Residence Participation.

<u>Exhibit B</u> is a summary of required RPP percentage and the actual RPP percentage by year since the program inception in 1991. The exhibit clearly demonstrates that the Department has met or exceeded the required percentages each year. In 2007, based on the 61 closed contracts, the actual target resident participation is 30.5%. DPW has surpassed the 30 percent threshold for each of the last four years.

Exhibit C illustrates the number of target resident workers that has been certified over the last 12 years. There were a total 609 newly certified workers in 2007. In addition, 307 new workers have been certified through early August 2008. There is currently a total of 3761 certified resident workers. The Department has continued to collaborate with community agencies to increase the pool of certified target resident workers. In addition to City staff, three agencies assist in certifying new workers for the Resident Preference Program. They are Esperanza Unida, The Milwaukee Urban League, and Big Step and are largely responsible for the recent spike in newly certified workers.

<u>Exhibit D</u> displays a series of columns including total target area residence hours spent on a particular contract, the percentage of resident worker hours of the total contract hours, and the percentage of resident worker wages of the total contract wages.

Based on hours, the actual percentage of resident worker hours achieved is 30.5%, and the percentage of the total contract dollar amount spent on wages that was paid to resident workers was 29.5%. These figures are notably close, indicating that the target resident workers are compensated the same average wage rate as all other workers on DPW contracts.

This exhibit also shows that, although not required, the average number of hours spent by Milwaukee resident workers is nearly 44.5 (14% higher than the target area residents). This number indicates that the contractors that perform DPW contracts have a considerable percentage of Milwaukee residents (target and non-target) in their workforce.

<u>Exhibit E</u> shows a race and gender breakdown of hours spent on DPW contracts. The Exhibit includes a chart that shows 97.9% of the work force on DPW contracts are male and 2.1% female. The chart also shows that 72.9% of the workforce is made up of white workers vs. 13.5 % and 12.5% African American and Hispanic respectively.

<u>Exhibit F</u> relates to the DPW apprentice program performance on 2007 closed contracts. Approximately 46% of the apprentices were of a minority group, which is consistent with the 45% minority apprentices witnessed in 2006. Also, target area residents worked over 38% of the apprentice hours on the 2007 contracts closed so far.

<u>Exhibit G</u> shows all job classifications occupied by target resident workers. In 2007, there were 19 different classifications with 405 total contract jobs.

DPW staff continues to provide important information to all potential bidders on any DPW contracts. This information emphasizes programs such as the Residency Preference Program, EBE, and Prevailing Wages. Furthermore, every time a new contractor is awarded a contract, a special meeting is held to discuss these programs at length in order to avoid any future and unnecessary noncompliance. In 2007, a one-on-one meeting was held with nine different contractors.

#### CONTRACTS REQUIRING LESS THAN 25% RESIDENT PARTICIPATION

In 2007, there were 133 formal construction contracts entered into by the Department of Public Works. Eighteen (18) of these formal contracts had no resident participation requirements or requirements that were less than 25%. In each case, the decision to reduce the normal resident participation requirement was made after discussions with the contracting division concerning the type and exact method of construction involved in the project. The decision to lower the participation requirement on each of these eighteen contracts was based on one or more of the following factors:

- 1. The work involved was highly specialized requiring skills and experience not represented on the list of eligible resident workers and not likely to be found in the population of potential target resident workers.
- 2. The contract was primarily for the purchase of equipment that could be installed by a small number of workers with specialized skills.
- 3. No local contractors performed the type of work required, meaning that the contractor selected to perform the work would not be from this area.
- 4. The project was funded either totally or in large part from a source other than the City. When non-City grant funds are used for public improvements, the grantor generally prohibits the City from imposing social requirements that exceed the standards and requirements of the grantor.
- 5. The contract is for services that will be provided on an unpredictable schedule. The best example is snow plowing. DPW signs up several small independent snow plowers. These small contractors generally have very few employees. Requiring them to meet RPP standards for work that is uncertain is unreasonable.



During the six-year time period between 1997 and 2002, an average of 147 residents were certified each year. In the sixyear period following 2002, 284 residents have been certified annually.

The 307 residents certified to participate in the Resident Preference Program during the first 8 months of 2008 is a direct indication of the continuous effort to keep this program viable. The last few years have seen more residents signing for the Resident gu Preference Program than was the case in the late 1990s.



This is especially the true

for 2007 and 2008. During these years, DPW has updated its list of certified residents in collaboration with area agencies involved in the program. Three agencies, Esperanza Unida, Milwaukee Urban League, and Big Step, also certify people to participate in the program. These agencies are strategically located near north side, near west side, and near south side, making them more accessible for potential resident workers. While becoming certified to participate in the Resident Preference Program does not guarantee anyone a job, it at least opens up potential opportunities.
