Dear Aldermen Donovan and Witkowski:

The intersection of West Oklahoma Avenue and South 27th Street experiences congestion throughout the day and there is a high frequency of crashes at and near the intersection. Preliminary engineering, approved under Common Council File No. 071689, has begun on a Highway Safety Improvement Grant that will close the first median opening on South 27th Street north of West Oklahoma Avenue to improve safety and reduce congestion. This project is scheduled for construction in 2009. Therefore, until construction is completed, we recommend installing signs to prohibit U-turns northbound and southbound at the first median opening on South 27th Street north of West Oklahoma Avenue.

We will prepare the necessary legislation that will be heard at the next Public Safety Committee meeting, so you may support it to final passage.

Dear Alderman Bauman:

Following the reconstruction of the Marquette Interchange, there are two southbound roadways on South 11th Street south of West Wisconsin Avenue. Vehicles turning right onto the southbound freeway ramp from West Wisconsin Avenue have to cross a moving lane on North 11th Street to make a turn on red, creating an unsafe situation. Therefore, we recommend signs be installed to prohibit turns on red from eastbound on West Wisconsin Avenue at North 11th Street.

We will prepare the necessary legislation that will be heard at the next Public Safety Committee meeting, so you may support it to final passage.
