Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.

This report is being submitted by Police Officer Robert GREGORY assigned to District 5-Late Shift.

On Sunday, April 19th, 2015, I was assigned to Squad 5321. At 6:20AM, I responded to 2905 W. Fond Du Lac Ave. (Fond Du Lac Quick Mart) to back up Squad 5312, Sergeant Todd KAUL, on a ShotSpotter.

When I arrived on scene SGT KAUL was talking with Thomas L. CAGE (B/M 08/14/1982). SGT KAUL told me that there were seven casings in the parking lot of the gas station. SGT KAUL also stated that when he arrived on scene, CAGE was walking away from the scene and there was a black female running away. SGT KAUL detained CAGE, but had to let the B/F run away. Also in the parking lot was a black Chevrolet Impala, bearing WI/450-WNE, and had a VIN# of 1G1125S36FU114906. The vehicle had been struck by one round in the front passenger quarter panel. I then walked CAGE to me vehicle and had him sit in the back, unhandcuffed. Squad 5390, Police Officer Richard MENZEL and Police Officer Emily MARKERT, responded and got a description of the B/F from SGT KAUL. Squad 5390 then saturated the area to look for the B/F.

INTERVIEW OF CAGE

CAGE stated that him and his friend were coming back from Chicago and his friend was taking him home. They saw a female subject (suspect) and his friend wanted to talk with the female because he thought she was attractive. They stopped and had a conversation with the suspect. The suspect then got into the vehicle. They then drove to the gas station (2905 W. Fond Du Lac Ave.) When they parked, the suspect they had picked up got out of the passenger front seat and started firing a gun. CAGE laid down in the back seat to duck from the gunfire. I then asked CAGE if the that was seen running away by SGT KAUL was the female that fired the gun. CAGE stated that was not the subject firing the gun, but rather the female subject running away was his girlfriend. I asked CAGE why she would not stick around. CAGE said because she had nothing to do with it and was too scared. CAGE was adamant did not want her to get involved with the incident. I then asked CAGE what the suspect looked like that was firing the gun. All CAGE could tell me was that suspect was a B/F. CAGE did not get a good look at her because he was in the back seat and she was only in the vehicle for a short time. I asked CAGE where the driver of the vehicle went. CAGE said the driver went to go run after the female that was firing the gun.

At this time, a B/M subject came walking in the parking lot of the gas station. The subject was walking from N. 29th St. CAGE stated that was the driver of the vehicle.

The subject was identified as Jason GRAHAM (B/M 04/05/1980).

INTERVIEW OF GRAHAM

GRAHAM stated that him and CAGE were in Chicago earlier in the night and drove home after bar close. CAGE had GRAHAM pick up the B/F subject that ran away from SGT KAUL. GRAHAM was on his way to take CAGE and the B/F subject home when they saw the suspect in this incident. They first saw her on N. 27th St. and W. Center St. GRAHAM thought the suspect was attractive and he wanted to talk to her. He then engaged her in conversation and asked her if she wanted to hangout. The suspect agreed and got in the front passenger seat. GRAHAM then told her that he wanted to go to the gas station to pick up cigarettes. The suspect did not want to go to the gas station and began to argue with GRAHAM. GRAHAM began to drive anyway and made his was to the gas station. GRAHAM parked the vehicle in front on the front door and put the vehicle in park. The suspect then got out of the vehicle and produced a handgun. GRAHAM did not know where she got it from. The suspect then began to fire at both GRAHAM and CAGE. GRAHAM got out of the vehicle and took cover behind it. When the gunfire was done, GRAHAM saw the female running towards N. 29th St. The female continued to run North bound on N. 29th St. and turned West bound through the yards at approximately W. Chambers St. GRAHAM then lost sight of the subject and returned to the gas station to see Police there.

None of the subjects ever entered the gas station. I spoke with the gas station attendant on duty at the time of the incident was Jezzay SINGH (W/M 09/10/1989). SINGH stated that he saw a female shooting a firearm at CAGE and GRAHAM. I asked SINGH if we could view the surveillance video, but SINGH stated he did not know how to work the system. SINGH stated he would call someone that does no know how and the Police could come back later. I notified LT. Boris TURCINOVIC that follow up would need to be completed to pick up the video. SINGH was very cooperative during the investigation.

On Saturday, December 12, 2015, I was assigned to the Wisconsin Wins Tobacco Initiative, which checks area vendors for age compliance tobacco purchases. Assisting in this assignment was Timothy M. WILKINS M/B 09/01/98 of 3526 W Sarnow St. Milwaukee WI 53209. WILKINS is 17 years old and not of legal age to purchase tobacco. A photo of WILKINS was taken at the beginning of the assignment for identification.

At approximately 9:10A, WILKINS entered Marathon Gas Station, located at 2306 W. Fond Du Lac Ave., and purchased a 2 Pack Swisher Regular Flavor Cigarillos. WILKINS provided a description of the cashier that sold him the tobacco. 1 entered the store and spoke with the cashier that matched the description. The subject was identified as Mohammad SOHEL A/M 04/15/71. SOHEL admitted to the sale and apologized.

SOHEL was advised an enrollment letter for the M.A.R.T.S. program would be mailed to the agent.

As of January 29, 2016, the agent had not enrolled in the M.A.R.T.S. program, therefore a citation was mailed for the violation.
