The officers observed two of the subjects begin to fight, punching each other in the head. The officers had to use OC spray to stop them from fighting. The subjects involved in the fight were cited.
- 10. On 10/16/07 at 8:56am, officers were dispatched to the gas station at 1909 W. Hopkins for trouble with a subject. The officers spoke with three customers whose cars stopped running after putting fuel in their vehicles. Mr. Zorn placed a red tag seal on the main storage tank and all pump nozzles, and advised the owner no gas was to be sold until the problem was fixed.

Officers interviewed the security guard who stated that four black male juveniles entered the store and two of them began taking items. When he approached one of them, he displayed a gun in his waistband. The security guard did not say anything to them and they all then fled on foot. Incident report filed (073000232).

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.

On Saturday, 05-16-15 at 3:48am, I responded to 1432 W Locust St, Locust Quick Mart, to check for a shooting scene. The location is 24 hr gas station. Upon arrival to the location I began to secure the scene and attempted to locate any evidence that might pertained to the shooting incident. CIB squad 9290 Det. Carlos RUTHERFORD arrived at the scene and located two casings in front of the location. At that time I secured the two casings and a bullet that was located in the same area of the casings. I maintained the scene until it was processed by both CIB and Forensic Investigator on scene.

I then interviewed the clerk on scene, Pavan SURAPUNETI (w/m 03-08-89). He stated that he had been on duty at the station all night. I asked him if he heard any shots fired earlier in the night. He stated that he heard a loud sound at approx. 2:30am. He stated that he did not know if it was a shot. He stated that someone came in the store and stated that someone was shooting, but that he was attending to customers at the counter. I asked him if I could review the store's surveillance system. He stated that the system is located in a back office, which was currently secured with a lock and that he did not have a key to unlock the lock. He stated that the owner would arrive at the location at 9:15am, and would give us access to the office.

There was a second clerk on scene, Pravegn VALLABHANGNI (w/m 05-06-91). I attempted to interview him, but there was a language barrier. A canvas was conducted on the on the home east of the station, 1410 W Locust St and 1412 W Locust St, with no answer.

The victim was identified as, Dionte T PAIGE (b/m 08-28-93, of 3611 N 37th St ph#414-366-3880), who stated that he was shot at the location after an altercation. He stated that he got shot at 5 times and struck once.

This report is written by PO Kevin SADOWSKI assigned to District Five, Early Shift. On Wednesday, September 2nd, 2015 at 5:13pm, I responded to 1432 W. Locust St regarding a battery, which occurred outside this address from a recently publicized You tube video.

Upon arrival, I spoke to a cashier, Palwander NMI SINGH (W/M 11-15-94) who stated that he remembered the incident occurring and a videodisc was made in anticipation of police investigating. Palwander handed me a copy of a CD from 8-18-15.

PO Jeffery KRUEGER of the Late Power shift, responded back to this location on 9-2-15 to speak with Raghu MULA (W/M 3-15-91) who was the clerk working when this incident occurred. MULA originally stated that he tried to call the police, but the phone wasn't working. Later on in the interview MULA stated he didn't call the police, because he always calls the police and the when the police arrive, the people who he is calling about have already left and then the police ask why he called the police. MULA stated he didn't call the police because everyone involved in the fight had already left.

MULA stated that the night of the incident, he observed the victim standing outside the gas station for approximately 5 min. He stated the male suspect walked in and she followed. The victim asked the suspect for a cigarette. The suspect told her he didn't have one. MULA stated the suspect and victim moved away from the window, and he couldn't hear what they were saying to each other. He stated the suspect then made a phone call, and approximately 5 minutes later, the suspect's either girlfriend or wife showed up.

MULA stated the suspect stated something to his wife/girlfriend about what the victim was saying. He stated they proceeded to assault the victim. After the assault the two suspects left, and the victim came into the store and asked for a cigarette. He stated she appeared drunk, and she left the store walking east.

I reviewed the video, which depicted a W/F, 20-30YOA, 200 lbs, green/white stripe shirt, black pants standing inside the store at 2:05am. The victim is then observed walking outside and then being assaulted by a B/M, wearing a black t-shirt with a white t-shirt underneath along with a B/F wearing a pink t-shirt. This video was placed on Milwaukee PD INV#15031438. As of September 3rd, 2015, this incident was not reported to police by the establishment, the victim or any witnesses. I notified the owner Jasjeet SINGH (w/m 4-14-65) of this incident on 9-3-15 at 6:05pm. This incident is currently being investigated.

This report is written by PO David LETTEER, assigned to District 5 late power shift, assigned to the Tavern Car, along with PO Russell MACRAE.

On 11-26-16 at 1:39 a..m., Sq. 5436 (PO SMITH and PO SMALKOWSKI), along with Sq. 5331 (PO DOLKIEWICZ and PO KREUGER) responded to the location of 3621 N. Teutonia Ave (Tha Competition Sports Bar), located in the city and county of Milwaukee, for a report of a shotspotter (single gunshot) and then a second shotspotter (6 gunshots) in front of the location.

Upon arrival, PO SMITH and his partner observed a fight involving several subjects, who were in front of the bar, which was open for business. PO SMITH stated in his report that once the subjects who were fighting observed the police and fled. PO SMITH and his partner approached the entrance to the bar and observed 7 spent casings just to the south of the main entrance to the bar.

As PO SMITH was checking for the casings a person whom he believed to be the bar manager, Justin FORNEY (b/m 03-18-80) exited the bar. FORNEY is the brother of the owner/licensee Isaiah F. WALLS (b/m 05-20-89). PO SMITH stated that the FORNEY exited the front door and stated to PO SMITH "They ain't shooting over here, they shootin across the street in the alley".

PO SMITH then asked FORNEY, "Across the street in the alley, not in front of the bar?" FORNEY stated, "Yes in the alley, ain't no one shootin over here, so you can go!" PO SMITH then used his flashlight and illuminated the sidewalk where he was standing, along with the casings and asked FORNEY "If they are not shooting over here, where did these (spent casings) come from?" FORNEY then looked at the casings, entered the bar and closed the door, locking it behind him. PO SMITH was not able to view the cameras regarding the fight or the shotspotter complaints, to see what had happened at the bar before the arrival of the police.

There are video cameras that capture the 3600 block of N. Teutonia Ave., as well as a camera that is above the front door or main entrance that captures east across N. Teutonia Ave. PO SMITH believes the cameras would have captured the incident. I asked PO SMITH if he could go back to the bar, when opened to see if he could or would be able to review the video and if possible capture the video.

It is unknown if the owner/licensee (WALLS) was on premise at the time of this incident, due to the officers having the door closed and locked on them and not being able to enter the establishment to review the video and speak to the owner/licensee if he was on the premise.

This report is written by PO David LETTEER, assigned to District 5 late power shift, assigned to the Tavern Car, along with PO Russell MACRAE.

On 11-27-16 at 1:11 a.m., there was a shotspotter at 3621 N Teutonia Ave., in front of the location. At 1:12 a.m., there was a shotspotter at 3611 N Teutonia Ave., 2 gunshots behind the house. At 1:13 a.m. there was a shotspotter at 3611 N Teutonia Ave., 2 gunshots in the street. At 1:14 a.m. there was a shotspotter at 3615 N Teutonia Ave., 6 gunshots in the street. Then a shots fired was called in at 1:16 a.m., where the caller stated that 7 gunshots had been fired through the window of Tha Competition Sports Bar.

Sq. 5332 (PO KRUEGER and PO KANDLER) responded to this call, as well as Sq. 5340 (PO RETZLAFF and PO ENGLISH). Upon arrival several people were leaving the area and getting into their vehicles. Officers observed that there were about 5 vehicles parked in front of Tha Competition Sports Bar and no other vehicles in the immediate area of the establishment. One of the vehicles parked in front of the establishment, a red minivan had a smashed out rear hatch door window. Officers attempted to locate the owner, but were unsuccessful.

Officers then checked Tha Competition Sports Bar., located at 3621 N Teutonia Ave. and found that there were no gunshots that had been fired into the bar from the outside, into the building; there was no damage to any of the windows. The bar at this time, appeared to be closed, as the officers attempted to knock on the door and make sure there was no one hurt inside the bar, as well as attempts to review the video. The video system at the bar captures north and south on N. Teutonia Ave., as well as east across the street from the bar. As the officers knocked, there was no answer, but a female did come back and also knocked on the door, attempting to get back into the bar. The female informed the officers that she left her phone inside the bar, which was open for business tonight, but again no one answered the door.

It should be noted the owner/licensee Isahah F. WALLS (b/m 05-25-89) drives a smaller 4 dr. orange in color vehicle and always parks his vehicle in front of the front door. I asked PO KRUEGER if there was such a vehicle parked in front of the establishment upon his arrival. PO KREUGER stated none of the vehicles parked there matched the description I gave him.

PA-33E Narrative

This report is written by PO David LETTEER, assigned to District 5, late power shift, Sq. 5436 (Tavern Squad).

On 08-28-16 at or about 2:26 a.m., PO WUNDER and I responded to a shotspotter, located at 3571 N. Teutonia Ave., as well as a shots fired, located at 3621 N. Teutonia Ave., in the city and county of Milwaukee. Upon arrival, we were informed by dispatch that a shooting victim was located and transported on N. 20th St. and W. Vienna St. and transported to St. Joseph's Hospital. While checking for a scene, were informed that the shooting happened across the street from Tha Competition Sports Bar, located at 3621 N. Teutonia Ave.

As we continued to check for a scene, PO MERRILL arrived, Sq. 5332 and located a single spent casing, in front of Young's Bar, located at 3573 N. Teutonia Ave. We confirmed with other squads that went with the shooting victim to the hospital, that the shooting victim was in the bar prior to being shot and that once the victim left the bar; he became involved in a fight and ultimately shot.

I went back the Tha Competition Sports Bar, and found that the owner of the bar, Isaiah F. WALLS (b/m 05-25-88) was exiting the bar and locking his doors, along with a Chicago style gate. I asked WALLS if we could look at his cameras and he stated "No, you can't, I am closing and going home." I asked WALLS for his identification card and he stated "You can come back tomorrow and look at the cameras." I asked him if he would personally be at the bar and he stated yes, "I will be open tomorrow." WALLS then left. WALLS has cameras that capture north and south on N. Teutonia Ave., along with a camera that is above his main entrance, which faces east across N. Teutonia Ave.

A neighbor, who was interviewed by PO ENGLISH, Sq. 5390, informed him that at the time of bar close, that the neighbor heard a commotion, looked out her window, observed cars and people lined up in the street in front of Tha Competition Bar, when someone got out of one of the cars in the street, retrieve something from the trunk of the vehicle and then heard gunshots.

It should be noted, through investigation by CIB, the victim Roman RODRIGUEZ (w/m 08-10-85) was in the bar, Tha Competition, with Kayla L. SMITH (b/f 10-04-92) and everything was good at the bar. Once RODRIGUEZ and SMITH were starting to exit the bar at closing time, a black male began hitting on SMITH. They walked out of the bar, where RODRIGUEZ grabbed SMITH, to get her away from the unknown black male and they walked to SMITH's vehicle, which was located south of the bar, in the area of N. Teutonia Ave and W. Finn Pl. Once at the vehicle, a different black male began to fight RODRIGUEZ, a crowd began to form and someone from the crowd fired a gunshot striking RODRIGUEZ, who started to run. As he was running he realized he was shot, hearing two or three more gunshots.

On 08-28-16 at 7:48 p.m., PO WUNDER and I returned to Tha Competition Bar, in order to meet with WALLS and review the video, but the bar was closed. We then went to Young's Bar, located at 3573 N. Teutonia Ave., to review their video cameras. The video at Young's is not good quality video and how they are positioned, would not have captured any evidence or information which would have helped us in this investigation.

While at Young's Bar, I did speak to Joyce Jenkins (b/f 04-07-51), who stated the night before, she was escorting a group from a birthday party out of the bar, when she observed several cars lined up in the street, in front of Tha Competition and about 15 people in the street, on both sides of the cars in the street, when she began hearing gun shots and what appeared to be cars trying to run over other people in the street. She stated she had the people from the party go back into the bar, where they hid in the bathrooms, until the shooting stopped. JENKINS stated she believed that the gunshots were coming from between Tha Competition Bar and the intersection of N. Teutonia Ave and W. Finn Pl. Jenkins went on to tell me that there are problems with the amount of people and parking due to the other bar (Tha Competition). She stated Young's Bar has tried to speak to the people that run Tha Competition Bar, but they do not listen. She also stated on the southeast corner of N. Teutonia Ave. and W. Finn Pl., the same family owns Tha Competition store, a convenience type store and the other business owners do not have a problem with that store, it is just the bar.

On 08-29-16, PO ROMEO and PO KLESCEWSKI, Sq. 5436, along with Sgt. Taylor, Sq. 5412 was sent by CIB to review and retrieve the video, but they were dispatched to a shooting at a different location.

On 08-30-16 at 4:30 p.m., Sq. 5280 PO GREGORY and PO RIVERA, was dispatched to Tha Competition to review the video, but the bar was closed.

On 09-01-16 PO WUNDER and I returned to Tha Competition at 8:32 p.m., but the bar once again was not open to the public. We knocked on the main door and there was no answer from anyone who could have been in the bar. PO WUNDER was able to stand on the bumper of our marked Tahoe and look into the window. He could not see anyone inside the bar. The lights were on and there were 4 orange traffic cones in front of the bar, blocking anyone from parking in front of the front door, but there appeared to be no one inside the bar.

On 09-02-16 at 12:04 a.m., PO WUNDER and I returned to Tha Competition, which was now open for business. We entered the bar, where I spoke to Justin, Forney (b/m 03-18-80) who was bartending. I asked him if he could access the video, I informed him that I was supposed to meet with Isaiah and he was to show me his video from the night of the shooting/fight. He informed me that Isaiah is the only person who has the access code to the video. I asked when Isaiah would be back and he could not tell me.

I still have yet to meet with WALLS in order to review the video.
