1. Description of Grant Project/Program (Include Target Locations and Populations):

Amani is one of the most economically distressed neighborhoods in Milwaukee, with high concentrations of poverty, unemployment, crime and disorder. This project seeks to build community capacity by developing a strategic plan with cross-sector partners utilizing an evidenced based approach to reduce violence and enhance community trust and quality of life in the Amani neighborhood. The target area is approximately 0.7 square miles from West Keefe Avenue to West Center Street and North 20th Street to the 30th Street Industrial Corridor. The population is 11,878 residents, the majority of whom are African-American (93%).

2. Relationship to City-wide Strategic Goals and Departmental Objectives:

This resolution is consistent with the mission and vision of the Milwaukee Police Department to reduce crime and disorder through community-oriented, evidenced based policing. The goal is to build capacity in Amani to create neighborhoods capable of sustaining civic life and improve partnerships with diverse stakeholders in the community.
