WHEREAS, *In June 2000, Glenn the transferred back to Comptroller's Office as FMIS project manager – applications specialist, was promoted to accounts director and later to deputy comptroller (January 2015); and*

WHEREAS, *Glenn Steinbrecher richly and justly earned the enduring praise and gratitude of his family, friends, coworkers and the community at large for his dedication and service to the City of Milwaukee and the Office of the Comptroller; now, therefore, be it*
