

**REASON FOR REQUEST:**

William Wilson, a City of Milwaukee police officer, was in the scope of his employment and operating a City of Milwaukee police vehicle that was traveling northbound on S. 16<sup>th</sup> Street. As the City vehicle entered the intersection of S. 16<sup>th</sup> Street and W. Rogers Street, the uninsured motorist, who was proceeding eastbound on W. Rogers Street, failed to yield the right-of-way by disregarding the official stop sign, causing the accident. As a result of the conduct of the uninsured motorist, there is liability on the City of Milwaukee pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 62.67 and the City of Milwaukee's Uninsured Motorist Self-Insurance Plan.

Officer Wilson sustained injuries to his head, hips, and right knee. The claimed medical expenses and lost wages total \$69,316.76.
