REASON FOR REQUEST:

William Wilson, a City of Milwaukee police officer, was in the scope of his employment and operating a City of Milwaukee police vehicle that was traveling northbound on S. 16th Street. As the City vehicle entered the intersection of S. 16th Street and W. Rogers Street, the uninsured motorist, who was proceeding eastbound on W. Rogers Street, failed to yield the right-of-way by disregarding the official stop sign, causing the accident. As a result of the conduct of the uninsured motorist, there is liability on the City of Milwaukee pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 62.67 and the City of Milwaukee's Uninsured Motorist Self-Insurance Plan.

Officer Wilson sustained injuries to his head, hips, and right knee. The claimed medical expenses and lost wages total \$69,316.76.
