



Sign C consists of a 24' long by 2' tall aluminum cabinet sign with push through letters. It will be installed in the name plaque area above the parapet on the south side of the building. It will be set flush to the wall and have concealed fasteners.

The applicant will enlarge Sign C so that it will measure 31 feet long by 2 feet 10 inches tall.



Sign B consists of a 26' long by 1'3" tall by 5" thick aluminum illuminated wall sign with push through copy. It will be installed at the entrance to the drive up area along North Water Street.

Sign B will now be smaller in length and will not exceed 26 inches.
