In accordance with the provisions of Section 320-21 (11) and (12) of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances, the Milwaukee Historic Preservation Commission has issued a certificate of appropriateness for the work listed above. The work was found to be consistent with preservation guidelines. The following conditions apply to this certificate of appropriateness:

<u>Unpainted brick must remain unpainted</u>. Letters and logo in frieze sign must be mounted to track so as to minimize the required attachment points to the facade. Individual letters in the sign may not be directly mounted to the building. <u>Any window or door replacement will require a separate COA</u>.

All work must be done in a craftsman-like manner, and must be completed within one year of the date this certificate was issued. Staff must approve any changes or additions to this certificate before work begins. Work that is not completed in accordance with this certificate may be subject to correction orders or citations.
