

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.



I would like to file an objection to granting a license to Lake Bluff Shell. I believe the filling station is in violation of State of Wisconsin Weights and Measures statute 100.18 (8). I filed a complaint with the City of Milwaukee on June 24, 2016. I received an answer from Anthony Hoffman of the City of Milwaukee Health Department telling me that my complaint had no merit. I have attached documents to this e-mail for your information.

In reading the statute I am convinced Mr. Hoffmann erred in his decision of this matter. I also believe that I shouldn't have to wait until April for a decision on this matter. I have not seen any filling stations that I know of that don't post their gas prices where you can see them BEFORE you drive into the station. Mr. Hoffmann also stated to me that the station has a letter from a neighbourhood group that allows their present situation to exist. The prices at this station are some of the highest in the City and I am sure not having them posted in a conspicuous location is the reason.

In closing I would hope the City will investigate this issue and if there is any information needed please let me know.
