



ALCOHOL BEVERAGE & PUBLIC ENTERTAINMENT PREMISES SUPPLEMENTAL PLAN OF OPERATION



They started raising their voices which at that time customers started getting worried like if something was going to happened. There were no security in the store and I text Harry Susman to let him know what was going on. At that time another three guys came that were with the couple that was arguing with the other gentleman and they were standing in the front door. It did not feel safe at all and there was no security. I asked Harry about the security and he said that the security from this store was pulled to go to another store due to a robbery. Well all this was going on me and my husband seen the gentleman that was mad and arguing with the couple started walking out of the store but he had a box cutter in his hand and I told the cashier which really he didn't do anything about it as to call the police. - 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.
