Regarding the Japanese maples, we could move them slightly farther from the house but the plan is to keep them trimmed to a manageable size. According to my manual from Johnsons Nursery, the mature size of these plants is $12 \text{øx} \ 12 \text{øbut}$ they will be kept to a much smaller proportion. Unlike larger scale maples the size and quantity of root development is far less and poses little to any risk to the foundation.
