

REASON FOR REQUEST:

Troy Johnson, a City of Milwaukee police detective, was in the scope of his employment and a passenger in a City of Milwaukee police squad car that was traveling southbound on North 35<sup>th</sup> Street with its emergency lights and siren activated. As the City vehicle entered the intersection of West Chambers Street and North 35<sup>th</sup> Street, the uninsured motorist, who was proceeding eastbound on West Chambers Street, failed to yield the right-of-way and collided with the City vehicle, causing the accident. As a result of the conduct of the uninsured motorist, there is liability on the City of Milwaukee pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 62.67 and the City of Milwaukee's Uninsured Motorist Self-Insurance Plan.

Detective Johnson sustained injuries to his head, neck, back, and bilateral knees. The claimed medical expenses and lost wages total \$20,776.60
