Representative David Crowley is a lifelong resident of the City of Milwaukee and is honored to serve the neighborhoods and the constituents to which he has known his entire life. He was elected in 2016 to the Wisconsin Assembly, representing the 17th District which encompasses much of Milwaukee's Northwest side. Representative Crowley currently sits on the following Assembly Committees: Criminal Justice and Public Safety, Small Business Development, Workforce Development, Transportation, and Jobs and Economy.

Born in May of 1986, David graduated from Bayview High School and attended the University of Wisconsin Milwaukee, where he studied Community Studies and Educational Policies. He credits his passion for public service to the time spent as a young adult with the youth organization Urban Underground. While with Urban Underground, Crowley served as Community Justice Coordinator, making a name for himself as a community organizer.

In 2010, David got his political start as the Statewide African American Organizer for U.S. Senator Russ Feingold's Senate Campaign Committee. He has since worked as a Senior Aide at both the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors and in the State Senate to State Senator Nikiya Harris Dodd. David is a board member of the Milwaukee Chapter of the ACLU and also serves as Chair of the Milwaukee Delegation for the 2017-18 legislative session.
