In accordance with the provisions of Section 320-21 (11) and (12) of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances, the Milwaukee Historic Preservation Commission has issued a certificate of appropriateness for the work listed above. The work was found to be consistent with preservation guidelines. The following conditions apply to this certificate of appropriateness:

Replacement downspouts must be installed in the same location as existing. No architectural features of the roof may be removed; eave trim and mouldings must be retained. If a metal other than natural copper is selected for gutters and downspouts, they must be painted or powder-coated; in such case, gutters should be white and downspouts colored to match surrounding brickwork. Chimney must be retained and appropriately flashed.

All work must be done in a craftsman-like manner, and must be completed within one year of the date this certificate was issued. Staff must approve any changes or additions to this certificate before work begins. Work that is not completed in accordance with this certificate may be subject to correction orders or citations.
