Q1 & Q2 Inclusion Numbers

REQUIREMENTS

- 18% professional service spending with SBE
- 25% construction spending with SBE
- 40% of on-site construction hours to be performed by City residents meeting RPP requirements
- Pay living wages to workers performing construction trade labor on project



Q1 & Q2 Inclusion Numbers

Highlights

- The Bucks have surpassed their RPP hours for the New Milwaukee Arena. The Bucks RPP% thru June 2016 is 55.7% (40%) which equates to 484.4 total hours.
- Professional Services contracts for New Arena is 18.1% and Block 7 Parking Structure is 25.6% for combined total of 18.7% (18%)
- © Construction services contracts for New Arena are 25% (25%)


