As per my conversation with Linda on 10-4-16 here is my description of the event in question.

On the weekend of October 1-2, I was in Milwaukee on business. I needed to travel from the hotel, Hilton Garden Inn at the airport, to Serb hall at 51st and Oklahoma on Sunday the second. I asked the hotel desk to obtain transportation for me, assuming it would be a cab. This was at 9:45 AM.

The driver showed up at about 10AM which was when the event I was going to opened. He was driving a Mercedes 250(?) with no meter inside from Klassic Limousine service. I didn't think much about a limo service showing up as many hotels I have stayed at have used these services for local trips. He asked me to wait in the car for a minute as he went into the hotel. He returned in short order and when asked about the fair responded that he would give a better rate than a cab company. When pressed again about the rate he told me it would be determined by mileage only. I had been told that the hall was only 5-6 miles away by another member of my group. I agreed to proceed partly as it would be very inconvenient to wait for another ride and I didn't think a 5-6 mile trip would be too much.

He continually attempted to reassure me that he would give me a good rate, lower than a cab company as he drove. We entered the freeway and I questioned it as I was told it was an easy trip just up the road and then a short left to the hall. He again tried to reassure me it was quicker this way around numerous traffic lights. The harder he tried to reassure me the more skeptical I became.

When we reached the destination he announced a distance of 9 miles and produced a card that looked like something anyone could print out on their computer with their rates on one side and cab rates on the other. His stated rate was \$35 for 9 miles and the cab rate was listed as \$45 for the same distance. I questioned the total but again was shown the card and told I was given a good rate. I paid the \$35 and asked for a business card so I could call for my return trip. I was given a professional card for Klassic Limousine Service with the name Latoun and phone number of 414-737-2896.

After my event I called a normal cab, American United, for my return trip. The fare to get me back to the hotel was \$22.75 and we used the freeway for a very short stint.

I feel that Klassic Limousine and the driver Latoun lied to me and misled me into paying an unfair rate for my trip.
