5. DESCRIPTION OF PROJECT:

Durham Hill Nursery has prepared a complete landscaping plan. We are NOT looking to have that landscaping plan worked on this summer. We plan to have this done in the spring and summer of 2018. We intend to present a further application for the entire landscaping plan at that time.

This application is strictly for some tree and brush removal strictly in the backayrd (nothing in the front yard) of the home. We believe this tree and brush removal work is necessary for the landscaping plan. We also believe this tree and brush removal is necessary regardless of the landscaping plan or whether it changes in scope (i.e., the landscaping plan shows changes to the front porch, but we do not intend or expect to actually do that, rather we wish to try to bring the existing front porch back to its original condition without changing the footprint).

This spring and summer we would like to remove one large tree in the backyard which is just to the east and south of the existing (delapidated) garage, because that tree overhangs on the garage, it overhangs on our neighbors' garage, and branches extend up to the roofline of our home, and therefore this tree causes lots of debris to clog the gutters. This tree will also need to be removed of necessity when the delapidated garage is torn down.

We would also like to remove the two existing, very tall but relatively thin gingko trees which are in the middle of the backyard, next to the two existing magnolia trees. These two gingko trees have become overgrown, and are adversely impacting the more desirable magnolia trees right next to these gingko trees. Removal of these two gingko trees is also part of the landscaping plan concepts.

Finally, we would simply like to "trim" up the existing, very large tree to the west and south of the property, and finally then also generally remove some of the overgrown bushes and very small trees in the backyard which hae become overgrown.

We have taken photographs of the entire backyard, which will be attached. The landscaping plan also shows the area, including where these trees are located (I don't know how to attach to this, but will send the attachments via separate email).

We do not know if this application requires plan approval or not. We would prefer to proceed with this work as soon as possible, however, and simply for that reason hope that this can be approved without the need to wait for a commission meeting.

Durham Hill Nursery works with a particular subcontractor, "Complete Tree Service," regarding tree
