Proposal Mothball certificate regarding current violations on windows, window glazing,

sidewalk vaults, spalling masonry, and others.

Staff comments This 1924 building is the second Modjeska Theater on this site, replacing an earlier

1910 building. The current building is Mitchell Street's last surviving movie palace and was designed by the iconic movie theater architecture firm of Rapp & Rapp who

were commissioned nationwide for movie palaces such as the Modieska.

Applicant is a for-profit entity wholly owned by a non-profit. While applicant is raising funds for repair, the current monthly fines are rapidly depleting the new funds that

are being brought in to fund the repairs.

Applicant has been making progress toward mitigating the violations. However, staff

would note that no COAs have been applied for many of the exterior repairs

mentioned in the application.

Applicant has provided three bids for replacement windows with this application. Two are wood and one is aluminum clad. The wood proposals appear approvable and

those details can be worked out with staff.

Applicant requests eight months to complete sidewalk vault work and to begin

window replacements at the end of this year (2017).

Recommend HPC Approval Recommendation

> 1. Direct applicant to obtain COA for already completed exterior work on masonry, emergency stairs, asbestos and lead abatement, and any other work recently completed for which no application was filed and for all future work.

2. Staff would like to see a timeline with specific dates and milestones, as the

timeline provided is somewhat general.

3. Staff would like a progress report at the December meeting and at project

completion.

4. Provide a bid on restoring what remains of the existing windows rather than complete replacement and direct applicant to pursue only wood replacement

windows if replacement is found to be necessary.
