Reconfigure rear facade with new entries and remove non-historic features. Infill with brick to match historic brick as needed. Infill door with modern hollow metal door. Staff comments This is one half of the Salentine Brothers building, which dates to 1860. The other half of the building has historically been under different ownership and remains so to this day. Applicant intends to install a historically sensitive storefront of all wood materials. It will consist of a bulkhead, main display window area, a transom, a frieze, and reproduction detailing at the top corners. Door trim has been aligned with windows. Applicant has agreed to order reproduction wood exterior windows for the upper floors that are two-sash and fill the full arch. The supplied drawings of the replacement windows are acceptable to staff. Overall, staff feels that new storefront meets approval criteria and recommends approval with conditions that primarily consist of additional documentation requirements. Recommendation Recommend HPC Approval with conditions Conditions 1. Low-E coating on glazing must be clear with no tint. 2. The cementitious board in the frieze/sign zone should have its butt joints sealed to be invisible and be painted to match surrounding materials until a tenant is found. Wood would be a preferred treatment here, but cementitious board is acceptable with these conditions. 3. Submit door hardware for review by staff. **Previous HPC action**
