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### **RE: Tree Pruning/Removal and Landscape Installation**

Claudia I'm glad we were able to find some time to meet. I feel it's always better to put a face with a name and it makes our job that much more satisfying and personable. It also allows us to gain a better understanding of the client's goals and desires with their landscape. I certainly appreciate that you've contacted us and hopefully we can facilitate a great experience for you. As we discussed today, there are some small changes I think we can make to help provide you with a more aesthetically pleasing landscape. I like to think of this as a progression of events that I'd like to see happen. First of all the tree removals and pruning, followed by the bed prep, finally fishing up with the landscape installation. If you have any questions or concerns please feel free to contact me.

#### **Tree Pruning**

- 1) Prune all crabapples with the following diameters along the south and west border of parking lot. (12",13",13",13",13",11.5",8",7.5",9",10",14",9") 12 Trees total. Prune to remove deadwood, sprouts at the base, and 1/3 of the sucker growth in the canopy where there is overcrowding. Shape as much as possible without removing more than 15% of the live crown.

#### **Tree Removal**

- 2) Remove 8" diameter arborvitae, 2" diameter volunteer ash, and yew in the northeast planting bed in front of the church and grind the stumps. Haul away the grindings.
- 3) Remove 9", 16.5", and 5" diameter arborvitae, 3" Norway maple, and 5" mulberry in the northwest planting bed in front of the church and grind the stumps. Haul away the grindings

#### **Bed Prep**

- 4) Clean out foundation planting beds, rake out leaves and garbage. Remove landscape fabric in planting bed along the east side of the church. Beds must be cleaned by CTL or client prior to landscape installation.

#### **Landscape Installation**

- 5) Till the soil in the planting beds on the northeast, and northwest corners of the front of the church where the tree removals occurred as well an area on the west side of the building surrounding the A/C unit, mixing in peat moss top soil, and 14-7-7 fertilizer (add topsoil where needed).
- 6) Install edging to define boundaries of planting bed and turf in areas listed in #4 as well as on the east side of the building between planting bed and driveway. Extend the bed to the northwest to encompass the A/C unit on the west side of the church. Approximately 150 feet of edging.
- 7) Furnish and install the following plant materials and mulch after planting to a depth of 2" surrounding plants and fill in newly established beds.
  - 5 Spirea Crispa Rose 15" pot
  - 5 Arrowwood Dentatum Viburnum 2'
  - 1 Chalet Swiss Stone Pine 3'
  - 2 Bluepoint Upright Junipers 5'
  - 12 Daylilies 4.5 qt standard (spaced between current plantings on east side of building).
- 7) Mulch to a 2" depth extending 3ft out from the trunk of 12 crabapples listed in item 1.
