This is in response to your request on behalf of the residents of the property at 1244 North 9th Street to install the above-captioned parking restriction.

Our traffic engineering staff has investigated this request and found that motorists exiting the underground parking lot at this address have a difficult time seeing traffic traveling eastbound on West Winnebago Street when vehicles park close to their driveway. Therefore, in the interest of public safety, we recommend installing this restriction to increase visibility at the driveway.

We will prepare the necessary legislation for the next Public Safety Committee meeting, so that you may support it to final passage.
