Observation: Routine Survey done at establishment today. Mouse droppings were noted throughout entire premise especially where chips are stored, back room and floor areas throughout. Evidence of possible harborage noted where floor section is missing near chip rack area. Many mouse droppings seen in area underneath floorboard where floor is missing, on cardboard boxes where food is stored, on shelves where food is stored throughout the store. On floor, underneath shelves, and equipment throughout the store were seen.

Corrective Action(s): Clean all evidence of rodents throughout entire premise. Provide effective pest control to eliminate rodents. Eliminate any possible rodent harborage's throughout premise.

Close facility and remain closed until rodent problem is undercontrol and health department has done a recheck and allows facility to reopen.

4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.

5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

6. You may then provide testimony.

a. Include only information relating to the above license application.

b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.

c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.

d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.

7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.

This report is written by Police Officer David NOVAK, assigned to the License Investigation Unit, Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

- 1. On 03/13/09 at 12:43 am, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 4747 N Hopkins St for an Armed Robbery complaint. Police attempted to enter the tavern but found the door locked. Police identified themselves and the bartender walked over to the cash register and buzzed the door allowing officers in. The bartender, identified as Theordis Terry, pointed out the victim and officers spoke with him. Investigation revealed the victim won some money while at the Potowatomi Bingo and had been at a couple of other bars before coming to Ealy's. Once at Ealy's, he bought a round of drinks. The victim stated he started talking to a girl who was with a guy or two and around 12:30 am he left the tavern. While walking to his car, the victim stated he could hear the girl talking on her cell phone telling someone he was leaving. Once at his car, a male approached him armed with a gun and a fight over the gun began. The suspect struck the victim once in the face with the gun causing it to discharge. The victim stated another suspect then ran up and punched him in the face. The suspects obtained the victim's car key's and cell phone and fled the scene. Officers spoke with Annabelle Ealy regarding the entry door being locked and Ealy stated she keeps it locked for her safety and buzzes patrons in after she gets a look at them. Ealy was advised that this violates city ordinance and that the door must remain unlocked or she will be cited.
- On 10/30/10 at 11:51 pm, Milwaukee police conducted a license premise check at 4747 N Hopkins Street. Officers spoke with Annabelle Rupert-Ealy and no violations were observed.

- 3. On 02/12/11 at 11:03 pm, Milwaukee police were dispatched to a Battery complaint at 4747 N Hopkins Street. Police spoke to the victim who stated another female who had a beer bottle attacked her causing the victim to sustain several lacerations to her face. The victim required 21 stitches to close the wounds. Police spoke with Annabelle Rupert-Ealy regarding this incident and Rupert-Ealy closed the tavern for the night so police could properly investigate.
- 4. On 07/03/2009 the applicant was cited at 4747 North Hopkins Street in the city of Milwaukee for Licensed Premises-Immediate Police Entry.

- 5. On 05/16/2014 Milwaukee police conducted a licensed premise check at Ealy's 00 (4747 North Hopkins Street). Officers verified that the business had the licenses displayed.
- 6. On 01/17/2015 Milwaukee police responded to a battery complaint at 4747 North Hopkins Street (Ealy's 00). At 1:35am there was a fight in the rear parking lot of the business. During the fight a subject was struck in the head with a pistol. The victim attempted to flee when an unknown armed suspect fired several rounds at the victims vehicle, striking the vehilce several times. Officers recovered 10 spent casings in the rear of the business. The agent stated it was motorcycle club night. The agent also stated she doesn't have security and the motorcycle club provides their own security.
- 7. On 03/22/2015 Milwaukee police conducted a t tavern check at 4747 North Hopkins Street (Ealy's OO). No violations were observed.
- 8. On 05/17/2015 Milwaukee police were dispatched to a shooting outside of Ealy's OO (4747 North Hopkins Street). Investigation revealed a patron of the bar became upset that his girlfriend was kicked out for starting a fight. This patron, Matthew Jeffries, began an argument with other patrons outside of the business and an unknown subject fired shots at Jeffries, striking him. Jeffries later confessed to retrieving a firearm from a subject in a vehicle and pointed this gun in the direction the gunshots had come from. An unoccupied vehicle was struck by gunfire. Jeffries was arrested for felon in possession of a firearm. Milwaukee police incident report #151370015 and 151370031 filed.
- 9. On 06/11/2015 a Milwaukee police officer observed a subject attempt to enter Gold Diggers (4750 North Hopkins Street) while carrying three pink colored beverages in plastic cups. The subject, Darryl Ball, told the officer that the drinks did contain alcohol and he had purchased them at Ealy's OO (4747 North Hopkins Street) with the intent of taking them to Gold Diggers. Ball stated he bought the drinks at Ealy's OO because they were cheaper than Gold Diggers

and he had walked out of Ealy's OO with them while the bouncer was on his phone. The officer advised the bouncer regarding this incident.

- 10. On 07/18/2015, Milwaukee police, along with agents from the Department of Revenue, conducted a tavern check at Ealy's OO (4747 North Hopkins Street). During this check, 12 bottles of liquor were found to be contaminated with bugs, 5 bottles of alcohol were confiscated for not having an invoice, and 2 bottles were confiscated for being retail purchases. Additionally, a firearm with a scratched off serial number was recovered from a cabinet under the register area. The applicant stated she did not know who owned the gun or why it was their and asked officers to remove it. The gun was removed by officers and inventoried.
- 11. On 07/19/2015 Milwaukee police responded to a shotspotter call at 4747 North Hopkins Street (Ealy's OO). Investigation revealed there had been a fight in the bar and at some point, shots were fired. The location of the shots fired was not determined. While investigating, officers became aware that a shooting complaint had been called in by St. Joseph's hospital and that this shooting complaint was related to the shots fired complaint at Ealy's OO.
