This is the second transfer amount to the worker's compensation special purpose account. Approximately 30% of the first transfer amount has been expended and the remainder will be spent by the end of November or early December. The worker's compensation account is projected to be between \$1.5 million and \$2.0 million over budget in 2008.
