
Dear Mr. Johnson:

We have received your claim for the amount of \$1,505.55 in relation to the vehicle damage you sustained on January 25, 2017 in the area of North 91st Street and West Mill Road.

Our investigation determined the Department of Public Works received eight calls reporting road hazard defects for the 6400 to 7200 blocks of North 91st Street from January 28, 2016 to September 1, 2016. The City responded to those complaints, and the areas were patched within seven days. The City did not receive any road hazard complaints for eight months until a complaint was received on January 24, 2017. A street maintenance patched the area of North 91st Street on January 30, 2017.

It is our view that the damage to your vehicle was not the result of any negligence of the City of Milwaukee. Therefore, the City is not legally liable for your damage. Accordingly, we are denying your claim.

If you wish to appeal this decision, you may do so by sending a written statement requesting a hearing within 21 days of the postmarked date of this letter to the
