In accordance with the provisions of Section 320-21 (11) and (12) of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances, the Milwaukee Historic Preservation Commission has issued a certificate of appropriateness for the work listed above. The work was found to be consistent with preservation guidelines. The following conditions apply to this certificate of appropriateness:

1. Lighting of the blade sign must be separately approved as it was not presented as part of the application.

2. Applicant is strongly encouraged to use a track/raceway to minimize penetration into the wall of the building, however, individual mounting is permitted as it is being installed on a non-original portion of the facade.

All work must be done in a craftsman-like manner, and must be completed within one year of the date this certificate was issued. Staff must approve any changes or additions to this certificate before work begins. Work that is not completed in accordance with this certificate may be subject to correction orders or citations.
