1. Description of Grant Project/Program (Include Target Locations and Populations):
Grant funds will offset a portion of the site amenities of the Fondy Park under construction. These amenities include artistic tables, a stage for local performers and educational messaging around the Fondy Park. The Park is a repurposing of a blighted vacant lot adjacent to the Fondy Farmers Market. The Park will simultaneously manage local stormwater to reduce the potential for local flooding as well as create a quality, new green space in the North Avenue/Fond du Lac commercial corridor – a neighborhood historically underserved of green space. The target residents of the Park are those living in the 53205, 53206 and 53208 zip codes. These zip codes share demographics of residents that struggle daily with joblessness, above average unemployment, poor health indicators and a significant percentage of the population at or below the federal poverty line.
2. Relationship to City-Wide Strategic Goals and Departmental Objectives:
This grant continues ECO HOME GR/OWN's mission to create healthy, green public spaces on Milwaukee's North Side. In addition, it meets the strategic goals of ECO, Department of Public Works and Milwaukee Metropolitan Sewerage District to construct stormwater management features across the City of Milwaukee, simultaneously helping reach the water goals set out in ReFreshMKE, the City's sustainability plan.
