The overall purpose of the Building Occupational Skills for Success (BOSS) grant program is to provide students with the skills and tools needed to become future business owners. The BOSS program includes a curriculum that will be offered to 425 students and their families at the Barack Obama School of Career and Technical Education to prepare them for both employment and entrepreneurship. The program is being offered in collaboration between the City of Milwaukee, Milwaukee Public Schools and the State of Wisconsin.
