Your Class A Malt & Class A Liquor License Application for "MJM Liquor" at 2229 W Fond Du Lac Av.

There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following recommittee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-2.7-4, probative evidence concerning whether or not a new license should be granted may be presented on the following subjects: whether or not the applicant meets the municipal requirements, the appropriateness of the location and premises where the licensed premises is to be located and whether use of the premises for the purposes or activities permitted by the license would tend to facilitate a public or private nuisance or create undesirable neighborhood problems such as disorderly patrons, unreasonably loud noise, litter, and excessive traffic and parking congestion. Probative evidence relating to these matters may be taken from the plan of operation submitted with the license application, if any, but shall not include the content of any music. Evidence regarding the fitness of the location of the premises to be maintained as the principal place of business, including but not limited to whether there is an overconcentration of businesses of the type for which the license is sought; whether the proposal is consistent with any pertinent neighborhood business or development plans, or the location's proximity to areas where children are typically present. The applicant's record in operating similarly licensed premises; and whether or not the applicant has been charged with or convicted of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the activity to be permitted by the license being applied for or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety or welfare may also be considered. See attached police report or correspondence.

Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

Limited parking for persons attending meetings in City Hall is available at reduced rates (5 hour limit) at the Milwaukee Center on the southwest corner of East Kilbourn and North Water Street. Parking tickets must be validated in the first floor information booth in City Hall.


4. On 01/27/2014 Officers conducted a licensed premise check on MJM Liquor at 2229 W. Fond Du Lac Ave. They discovered 4 opened cartons of cigarettes, which contained 25 packs of cigarettes. These packs were found to not have a State of Wisconsin tax stamp, which prohibits them from being sold in Wisconsin. The clerk was Dewayne KENNEDY and he stated he did not know where the invoices were for the cigarettes. The applicant was called by phone and stated the invoices were in the locked backroom. She stated she was unaware of the untaxed cigarettes and would make sure this did not happen again.

5. On 05/19/2016 officers responded to a subject with weapon complaint at 2229 W. Fond du lac Av. The clerk called because there was a subject armed with a cane that was refusing to leave. The officer advised both parties.

- 6. On 08/14/2016 officers responded to 2229 W. Fond du lac Av for a fire investigation. The building was set on fire as part of "Civil Disturbances" on 08/13/2016.
- 7. On 10/02/2016 officers responded to 2229 W. Fond du lac Av for a burglary complaint. The officers found the rear board on the closed business had been removed and an unknown amount of property was removed.

Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing. Please review the information below and if you have further questions regarding this process, please contact the License Division at (414) 286-2238.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.



I could not attend the hearing scheduled for today, May 31 at 9:30am because of employment schedule issue. However, I strongly oppose the renewal of Mr. Crossley's application to continue the tattoo and body piercing business The reasons are:

- 1. Since the opening of the tattoo and body piercing store, I've been having problems with his customers trespassing my private parking lot. I have no-parking signs in several visible locations. I've called City parking enforcement office several times to have these people ticketed and towed but by the time the officer arrive, which is any where between 30 minutes to one hour, the people already left. They either block the entrance to my private parking lot or park in it as if they own the property. I've spoken to the customers asking the customers to move their vehicle and pointing to the signs, they've threaten, ignore, and treated me with indifference.
- 2. This business brings people who have no respect for people, property, or rules. They throw trash all over the place. Some customers smoke marijuana and loiter in front of the store and my home until as late as 11pm with loud music and talking, especially during summer and fall months. They make inappropriate remarks and gestures towards my girls. We are afraid to go outside because of these types of people.

Please consider my written testimony and do not renew the license application for Mr.

13. On 09/30/15 at 3:32 pm, Milwaukee police investigated a complaint of possible synthetic marijuana being sold at Hustlin Hands Tobacco and Accessories at 3714 W Vliet Street. Undercover police officers entered the establishment and requested to purchase single cigarettes from an employee that was behind a partially enclosed counter. The undercover officer purchased two Newport brand cigarettes, which were fifty cents apiece. Another UC entered and approached the same store employee and requested to purchase synthetic marijuana. The employee advised the UC that it would be \$15.00 for his request. The UC purchased a package with the brand name "Wolfpack" on the front. Uniformed officers, as well as agents from the Department of Revenue, entered the business and conducted a license premise check. The store employee, identified as Rico Townsend, was very agitated and uncooperative, refusing to answer questions. Investigation found that Townsend was found to be in possession of suspected marijuana. Officers also recovered evidence of the earlier buys, as well as two spiral notebooks with information noted on the daily transactions of the business which also included documentation of the purchase of K2 for \$15.00 and single cigarettes for \$1.00 by the UC officers. Agents confiscated a box that contained several packages of "Wolfpack" that was found on a table behind the counter. An officer contacted the licensee, Paris S Crossley and advised him of the situation at his establishment with Crossley stating he was on his way to the business. Crossley never showed up. Agents KING and UHLIG confiscated all cigarette and tobacco products as there were no invoices on the premises. The clerk, Rico TOWNSEND, was cited for Unlawful Sale of Cigarettes and currently has a warrant for said citation. (15058516)

^{14.} On 01/22/17 at 6:46 pm, Milwaukee police responded to 3716 W Vliet Street for robbery/attempt kidnapping complaint. Police spoke with an employee, identified as Kenny Winters, who stated he was tattooing a subject when 3 masked males entered the business all armed with guns. Winters stated that one of the subjects stated to him something similar to, "Hey Kenny, let's talk outside". Winters stated he was frightened and did not know what the subjects wanted, so he and another guy who was in the business ran to the rear of the store and out the back door. Vliet St. An employee of the tatoo shop, Kenny WINTERS (m/b, 01-23-92), (#414-501-9852) called 911 and reported a group of males had entered the tattoo shop with firearms and where attempting to rob and/or kidnap him.

Upon our arrival, we located the caller/employee WINTERS, his relative, Lure WEBB (m/b, 01-17-96) coming from the rear of the business located at 3716 W. Vliet St. H&H tattoo is connected to Hustlin Handz Signs (3714 W. Vliet St.) by a rear room. Upon checking Hustlin Handz Signs, an employee Edward PACKER (m/b, 11-25-93) #414-690-1487) and two customers, Justice KING (m/b, 07-02-1999) and Octavius BOLTON (m/b, 10-28-92) were located in a bathroom. Also located in bathroom were two handguns.

In the back room, connecting 3714 and 3716 W. Vliet St., in plain view, a clear plastic bag, containing a green leafy substance, supsected marijuana was located. Also observed were three (3) glass pipes with marijuana residue inside. The tattoo shop and rear room had a strong odor of burnt marijuana. P.O. DEL MORAL tested the green leafy substance, which tested positive for THC, marijuana, 0.36 grams. The marijuana was placed on MPD inventory #17002632. The glass pipes were placed on MPD inventory #17002629.

I spoke with the caller, WINTERS who stated he was tattooing KING when three (3) black males walked in the business. WINTERS stated all three (3) were wearing black full face ski masks. WINTERS stated all three (3) were wearing all black clothing. WINTERS stated one subject was armed with a silver/black semi automatic pistol. WINTERS stated the second subject was armed with a semi-automatic rifle. WINTERS stated the first male stated to him something similar to "Hey Kenny, let's talk outside". WINTERS stated he was frightened and did not know what the subjects wanted, so he and WEBB ran to the rear of the business and out the back door. WINTERS stated the subjects ran out the front door.

During the investigation, I checked the posted lienses for both 3714 and 3716 W. Vliet St. The following is the information I gathered from the licenses on the premises;

Vliet St. H&H tattoo is connected to Hustlin Handz Signs (3714 W. Vliet St.) by a rear room. Upon checking Hustlin Handz Signs, an employee Edward PACKER (m/b, 11-25-93) #414-690-1487) and two customers, Justice KING (m/b, 07-02-1999) and Octavius BOLTON (m/b, 10-28-92) were located in a bathroom. Also located in bathroom were two handguns.

In the back room, connecting 3714 and 3716 W. Vliet St., in plain view, a clear plastic bag, containing a green leafy substance, supsected marijuana was located. Also observed were three (3) glass pipes with marijuana residue inside. The tattoo shop and rear room had a strong odor of burnt marijuana. P.O. DEL MORAL tested the green leafy substance, which tested positive for THC, marijuana, 0.36 grams. The marijuana was placed on MPD inventory #17002632. The glass pipes were placed on MPD inventory #17002629.

I witnessed the clerk sell a black and mild to a minor. I would like to file a complaint with the licensing committee regarding this incident. I would also like to file a complaint with the Health Department. The candy I purchased that same day was stale, expired, and old. I can safely assume that many of their products on the shelf for sale are beyond the "best by" sale date.

I am requesting that the City arrange for a sting operation checking the quality of food sold there and the potential sale of tobacco products to minors.

Below is a more descriptive account of the incident that occurred on 12 9 16.

Last week Friday, waiting in line to buy gas at the Citgo on 9th and Center, a freshman student of mine walked in with his friend, another student of mine, said hi, then proceeded to ask me to buy him a black and mild. I told him no, reminded him how addictive and deadly those products are, especially to people of color, bought my gas

and walked out. I decided to wait in the lot for the students to come out. They came out with the pack of black and mild's in hand. When I confirmed with him that the clerk sold this to him, he responded by saying, "yes, and its about time!".

I went in there and told the clerk that I just saw him sell tobacco to a minor. I reminded him that his business is a block away from my school. Then I told him that I would be reporting this to the Alderman.

There has been no reply yet from Alderman Russel Stamper. My instincts tell me to not wait on the City and its processes. We know these kinds of transactions occur regularly in certain distressed areas. The kids know which corner stores provide access to tobacco and liquor too.

I propose the school take a stand with me by boycotting this gas station. I believe it is in the best interest of our school, our children, and the surrounding neighborhood to not turn a blind eye to this violation when we know it happens regularly. The students need to know we care about their health and the community needs to know that we want responsible businesses serving our neighborhood.

If you desire to take some action and speak out on this matter with me, please reply back to this email or give me a call at We as a community have an opportunity to set an example for other slum gas stations and corner stores that prey on our black youth.
