Dear Mr. Crawford and Mr. Schoenfeldt:

This is to notify you that on October 14, 2008, the City's Licenses Committee voted to recommend to the City's Common Council that your renewal application for a Class "B" Tavern license for the premises at 235 North 36th Street ("Ark Inn") be renewed with a sixty (60) day suspension based upon a police report.

On November 5, 2008, you were sent a true and correct copy of the findings of fact, conclusions of law and recommendations of the Licenses Committee with respect to your renewal application for a Class "B" Tavern license in which the Committee recommended that your license be renewed with a sixty (60) day suspension. You were further notified that the Milwaukee Common Council would consider the matter at its meeting of November 25, 2008 commencing at 9:00 a.m. in the Common Council Chambers on the third floor of City Hall, 200 East Wells Street, Milwaukee, Wisconsin. You were advised of your right to file written objections and to appear personally or by counsel to address the Common Council. At that date, time and place you did appear, and you did file written objections to the report of the Licenses Committee. You were represented by Attorney Mark A. Schoenfeldt, 135 West Wells Street, Suite 340, Milwaukee, Wisconsin.

Following consideration of the report of the Licenses Committee and your objections and arguments, the Common Council adopted the recommendation of the Licenses Committee by a vote of thirteen (13) ayes, zero (0) noes and two (2) excused to renew your Class "B" Tavern license for the premises at 235 North 36th Street in the City and County of Milwaukee, Wisconsin ("Ark Inn") with a sixty (60) day suspension based upon the police report.

Said suspension is to be in effect between 12:01 a.m., November 29, 2008 and midnight, January 27, 2009.
