Delvyn Crawford, President/CEO Gutter Enterprises LLC

Delvyn Crawford is an author, poet, and fatherhood specialist. He provides

innovative ways for fathers to get engaged, and connects them to the resources that they need to become better fathers and role models. Delvyn is also a public speaker, multimedia communicator and musician who uses different mediums to convey a message of hope. A respected orator, Delvyn has delivered presentations for Johnson Controls, Marquette University, BMO Harris Bank, and other organizations across the United States.



At the Annual Fatherhood and Healthy Marriage Grantee conference in Washington, D.C., Delvyn was 1 of 4 people to be selected out of 500 to participate in FED Talks, which provided grantees the opportunity to engage in peer-to-peer and share ideas for tomorrow. The PBS Television Network created a documentary involving Delvyn and his work as a Fatherhood Specialist; which highlighted Black Male Achievement and the barriers that fathers face in the community. The documentary, entitled "Teaching Fatherhood," has received national attention and recognition throughout the world. In 2016, Delvyn was commissioned by Governor Scott Walker to participate on the Future of the Family Commission to explore ways that policy can be developed to help uplift families and aid them in attaining self-sufficiency.

An author and poet, Delvyn has a natural ability for storytelling, and can create poems that address everything from childhood trauma to the love between a man and a woman. A true performer, he stands out in live performances and holds the attention of his audience.
