5. DESCRIPTION OF PROJECT:

Restoration of the front entry portico base. The work includes demolition and in fill of the existing hollow plinth.

The new portico floor will be 8" of concrete with heating coils embedded in the top 4". The hollow plinth is in filled with rigid insulation topped by a 4" structural concrete base and a 4" topping of red tinted concrete.

The granite stairs will be disassembled, excess mortar and sand removed by hand scraping and/or electric grinder and power washed to remove atmospheric staining. Small areas of rust will be spot cleaned with "Sure Klean's" ferrous stain remover. This liquid product is hand brushed on to a wet surface area of stain, left to set for a varying time, then rinsed off.

The steps will be re-set on existing stringers with heating coils installed underneath the treads. A sample cleaning can be provided when the steps are removed.
