
The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

1. On 03/20/2009 at 9:03pm Milwaukee Police were dispatched to an armed robbery complaint at 3876 N. Port Washington Avenue (Port Supermarket). Investigation revealed 2 subjects, one of which was armed with a handgun, entered the store and demanded money. No injuries were reported. Milwaukee Police incident report number #090790159 filed.

2. On 05/29/2012 Milwaukee police, along with an agent from the Wisconsin Department of Revenue, conducted a licensed premise inspection at 3876 North Port Washington Avenue (Port Supermarket). The agent advised the cashier that they should not transfer bottles of liquor from other locations to this store and that they should not have open packs of cigars for individual sales.

3. On 03/23/2016 Milwaukee police, along with Agent Georgeanne King of the Department of Revenue, conducted a licensed premise check at 3876 N. Port Washington Rd. (Port Foods). The officer advised the applicant that the clerk, Vawnera Echols, needed to have a class D operator's license if he is going to leave her alone in the store. Additionally, Echols needs to attend the next Robbery Prevention class.

- 2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.




