Partnerships: Foster new and strengthen existing cross-system partnerships to more effectively and efficiently improve outcomes.



Community of Practice: Facilitate a cross-sector community of practice to support on-the-ground efforts, shape policymaking, and inform advocacy efforts.



Best Practices: Improve and promote best practices proven to positively address social determinants and improve life outcomes at the program and system level.



Resource Development: Develop interdisciplinary resources that support sustained collaboration such as cross-system data sharing agreements and other implementation tools.



Online Collaboration: Maintain HousingIs.org, a virtual gathering place for experts from various support systems to promote effective programs and share innovative ideas.



Policy & Advocacy: Convene researchers, practitioners, and decision-makers to advocate for smart policies that impact low-income people.



Training & Education: Provide training and education across systems and sectors aimed at treating housing as a cornerstone social determinant.
