Proposal Construct pre-fabricated metal gazebo in back yard. Remove swing set and partially

pave area occupied by swing set with bluestone. Re-sod and plant new plantings

around back yard.

Staff comments This appears before the Commission due to two separate complaints about the

installation of a painted steel gazebo with a standing seam roof. Advance approval was not obtained for the structure and additional landscaping work was performed

without advance approval.

The landscaping work is clearly within guidelines, using natural materials and replacing and renewing some plantings. This landscaping work should be approved.

The gazebo must technically be reviewed under the standards for new construction. Had the owners approached staff in advance of construction, the current structure would have been discouraged and the applicant steered in another direction. Wood or wrought iron is most likely what would have been recommended. It is noteworthy that standing seam roofs have not traditionally been allowed by the Commission at residential properties. A building permit was also required and was not obtained.

Based primarily on the complaints, staff recommends denial of the present steel

gazebo.

Recommendation Recommend HPC Denial of Gazebo. Recommend HPC Approval of all other

landscaping.

Conditions No conditions on landscaping.

If the gazebo is to be approved, comply with the following conditions:

Contact Development Center and

1. Obtain building permit. Permit center staff have informed us that the installation of

such a large and heavy object must be permitted.

2. Verify and comply with any setback requirements.
