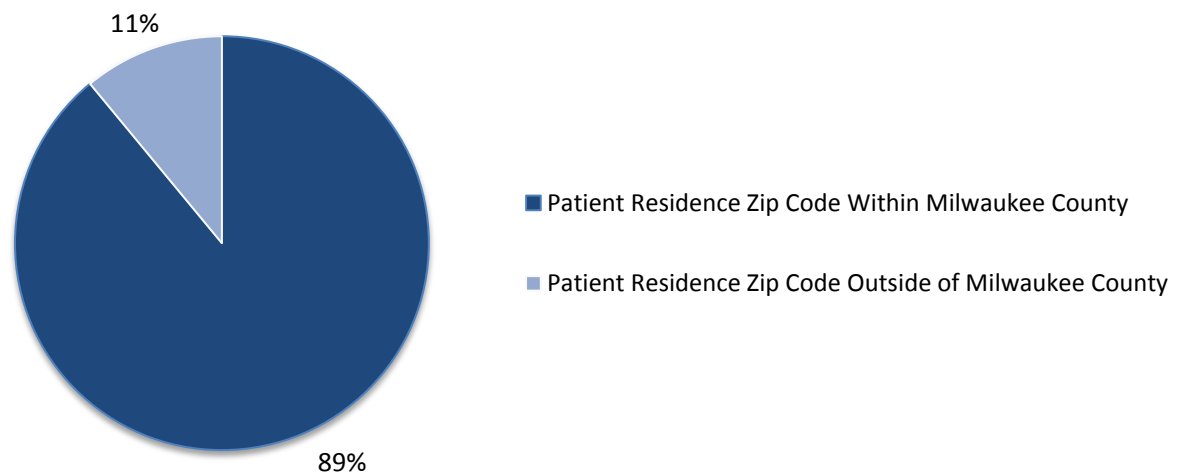


Comparison of Patient Residence and Overdose Location by Zip Code for all EMS Responses in Milwaukee County Between 2014 and 2015 for Suspected Opioid-Related Overdose Based on Naloxone Administration



EMS patients whose overdose location was in the same zip code as their residence.	62%
EMS patients whose overdose location was NOT in the same zip code as their residence, and residence was <u>within</u> Milwaukee County.	27%
EMS patients whose overdose location was NOT in the same zip code as their residence, and residence was <u>outside</u> of Milwaukee County.	11%

Between 2014 and 2016 there were 3,519 EMS responses in Milwaukee County for a suspected opioid-related overdose based on naloxone being administered. Among those patients, 89% had a residence zip code within Milwaukee County. Further, 62% of overdoses occurred in the same zip code as the victim's documented residence.
