Tim,

The cupola measures 13' high and 6' 10" wide. We are removing and rebuilding all 8 louvers and all the trim. Our crew is being dilligent about replicating exactly the louvers and trim. The curved mouldings are being made by Essmann's Millwork. The wood being used is the best quality clear pine. The tin roof is rusted through and will be removed and replaced with a copper roof of the same flat seam panel design. The finial is being duplicated in copper. I'm sure there was a point above the sphere originally which we will replicate. Lueder's painter will paint all the trim from our scaffold when we are finished. I'm assuming from our discussion that this is what you need to give approval.
