- 2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.





This Report of Incidents Involving Licensed Persons or Premises, original report, was submitted by P.O. Martinez MOORE PS# 015951 assigned to District 4, Late Shift.

On Saturday, January 7, 2017, at 12:09 A.M., Squad 4365, P.O. Ralph MCCLAIN and I, was dispatched to a shooting at 7424 N. 60th St., Brett's Farmhouse.

Upon our arrival, P.O. MCCLAIN and I entered the tavern through the west entrance door. Once inside, I observed a black male, later identified as Frederick P. JACKSON B/M, 04-03-86 address of 6036 W. Port Av.; Milwaukee, WI 53223, laying in a supine position, alongside the fixed bar, on the east side of the tavern. JACKSON'S head was facing towards the east wall, and he feet were facing towards the west wall. Frederick JACKSON was unresponsive and suffered a gunshot wound to the upper left side of his chest. A male subject, later identified as Andre L. HOLLY B/M, 02-05-84 address of 5316 N. 51st Blvd.; Milwaukee, WI 53218, was also observed knelt against the right side of JACKSON. P.O. MCCLAIN conducted an assessment of Frederick JACKSON and determined he was not breathing. Afterwards, P.O. MCCLAIN immediately performed CPR.

P.O. MILLER and I then conducted a Protective Sweep of the tavern and did not locate the suspect. Soon thereafter, the Milwaukee Fire Department arrived on scene and continued CPR. Contemporaneous to MFD conducting CPR, they advised me that JACKSON was pulseless and non-breathing.

After the tavern was rendered safe, I ascertained a description of the suspect/ shooter, from the tavern's cook, identified as Richard J GLEISSNERW/M, 11-29-66 address of 6915 N. 67th St.; Milwaukee, WI 53223, cell phone #550-4864. I then broadcast a description of the suspect via open sky.

Afterwards, Brett's Farmhouse owner, identified as Brett A. HENNING W/M, 12-11-58 address of 4322 W. Woodale Av.; Brown Deer, WI 53223, cell phone# 358-3400, escorted me to his camera system. The camera system is located in the basement. Aforementioned camera system records in real time, however there is no audio. Furthermore, majority of the cameras are in black and white, with the exception of the camera labeled "Seating Area." After viewing the camera system, I observed the following chain of events. The following is a synopsis of the incident.

10:04 P.M.- Suspect, described as a Black or Hispanic Male, approximately 5'7", 140 to 150 pounds, slender built, light brown complected, tattoo on the left side of his face, wearing a red baseball-style hat, blue jacket with the wording "Notorious" printed over the top of "Pelle Pelle", blue jean pants, park a possible Buick in the south parking lot. Suspect stayed stationary in the vehicle until approximately 22:18.

10:18 P.M.- Aforementioned suspect observed entering the east entrance of the tavern with the victim, Frederick JACKSON, and a material witness, Andre HOLLY. All three patrons continued to converse amongst each other and consume alcoholic beverages; mostly by the west side of the bar.

12:00 A.M.- Verbal altercation ensues between unknown suspect and two unknown black male patrons. Victim, JACKSON, leaves from his seated area of the bar and engage in a fight with the unknown male patrons. Suspect retrieved a handgun from his person then discharge the firearm striking Frederick JACKSON upon his chest. JACKSON immediately falls supine to the ground. Soon thereafter, patrons are observe hastily and frantically running from the tavern. Unknown suspect is then observed engaged in a verbal altercation with a patron that was observed on the floor. Patron appeared to be pleading with the suspect. Suspect is observed placing the handgun back into his jacket. Patron then flee from the tavern.

Afterwards, Andre HOLLY is observed entering the east entrance door. HOLLY and the suspect is observed conversing momentarily. Andre HOLLY and suspect are observed moving hastily towards the west entrance door. HOLLY brandishes a firearm from his waist. HOLLY and suspect exits through the west entrance door

and observed in the south parking lot. It is unknown the circumstances that transpired outside in the parking lot at this time. However, HOLLY and the suspect are observed surrounding a dark colored vehicle, possible Cadillac, by the entrance of the parking lot. HOLLY and the suspect re-enters the tavern. Moments later, HOLLY hands his firearm to the suspect. Suspect exits through the west entrance door, enters his vehicle, then flee from the scene.

Synopsis concluded.

This incident was depicted on the following cameras:

Camera labeled "Parking Lot"- This camera is located on the exterior of the building, affixed on the south side. The camera is approximately 15 feet from ground to affixed point. Aforementioned camera face southbound and oversee the south parking lot. This camera is depicted in black and white.

Camera labeled "Bartender"- This camera is mounted on the east wall. The camera is approximately 7 1/2 feet from floor to affixed point. It shall be noted that the ceiling is approximately 8 feet from floor to ceiling. The camera face westbound and oversee the bar and partially the patron stool area. This camera is depicted in black and white.

Camera labeled "Seating Area"- This camera is mounted on the west wall, above the window. The camera is approximately 7 1/2 feet from floor to affixed point. The camera face eastbound and oversee the lounge area. This camera is in color.

Camera labeled "Bar"- This camera is mounted on the west wall. The camera is approximately 7 1/2 feet from floor to ceiling. Aforementioned camera face eastbound and oversee the west side of the bar. This camera is in black and white.

Succeeding this investigation, Andre HOLLY was summarily arrested for Probation Violation (knowingly and intentionally admittance to consuming alcohol, violation of a stipulation of his probation). HOLLY was subsequently conveyed to Central Booking by Squad 4330, P.O. Bradley BAKER.

It shall be also noted that there were two identified underage patrons in the tavern during this incident. These patrons were identified as Nasia B. MARTIN B/F, 06-12-96 (20) address of 1605 Dover Drive; Waukesha, WI 53186, cell phone# 510-7502; and Jamiah S HOLT B/F, 03-15-96 address of 2101 W. Present for this meeting was Captain Andra Williams, P.O. Carrie Resnick, myself and Brett Henning. The meeting took place inside Captain Williams office at District Four.

Captain Williams asked Henning, what security measures he has in place at this time. Henning stated he currently has a video surveilance system in place. Currently there are a total of eight cameras, interior and some exterior, but that is it. Henning stated his tavern is similar to "Cheers". It is a very family orientated place and most of the customers know each other. Henning stated he hates guns, and his regular customers know this, and he does not allow guns inside the tavern. Captain Williams asked "How do you handle a fight in the bar?" Henning stated "I'll get in between them before it escalates. We don't have the problems other taverns do. During the day, the average age is anywhere from 40-70 years of age. The music we play is 95.7 (Oldies). The evening age range is from 30-40 years of age. The evening music is 98.3 (R&B). On the weekends there might be a crowd of 50-60 patrons.

Henning stated, I've been here for 28 years and this was horrible. I don't want anything like this to ever happen again.

Captain Williams stated, we need to keep an open line of communication. If there is ever a moment he is feeling uncomfortable with the crowd, he can call into the District and request for a squad to respond and conduct a tavern check or a walk through.

The following were recommendations made by District Four: Have security at the door, during weekend hours. Use a security wand to make sure no weapons make it into the tavern. Post No Firearms allowed signs, on the exterior doors.






