I have enclosed the 2nd application for the brick facade at 2446 N Lake DR.

I have also enclosed samples that are somewhat close to the original brick.

The Belden is available in standard size (2-1/4" H X 8"W).

The Bowerston is only available as modular, but a closer patern match. With the Bowerston, there are two sample boards, one would be of the color match. The other is the ntexture. The manufaturer does have enough of the color blend which best matches, with the pattern that is on the other board.

The 3rd option, CalStar are long bricks which could be cut toi the length we need.

These samples are as close to the original as we are going to find, so hopefully, the commission approves one of them. We are running out of time on good weather and would like to get this wrapped up as soon as possible. I can bring the samples into your office when you have time to meet.
