## **REASON FOR REQUEST:**

Linda Laura-Culbreath, a City of Milwaukee DPW employee, was in the scope of her employment and operating a City of Milwaukee vehicle that was traveling eastbound on West Hampton Avenue. As the City vehicle entered the intersection of West Hampton Avenue and North 92<sup>nd</sup> Street, the uninsured motorist, who was proceeding southbound on North 92<sup>nd</sup> Street, failed to yield the right-of-way by disregarding the traffic light, causing the accident. As a result of the conduct of the uninsured motorist, there is liability on the City of Milwaukee pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 62.67 and the City of Milwaukee's Uninsured Motorist Self-Insurance Plan.

Ms. Laura-Culbreath sustained injuries to her neck, left shoulder, and left knee. The treating physicians indicated that the left shoulder injury and the left knee injury are permanent. The claimed medical expenses and lost wages total \$97,797.43.
