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Hello,

I am a resident at Prospect Towers, [1626 N Prospect Ave. #2108](#) and I am writing because I am concerned about the proposed high rise at [1550 N. Prospect](#). This is a very dense block already. If I have a guest visit they are already unable to find street parking, and adding another high rise to the block will only make this worse. Additionally, there are so many delivery trucks (USPS, UPS, Amazon, Pea Pod) regularly on this street serving all of the residents, that adding another high rise with 27 floors will only increase the amount of deliveries and in turn traffic. I am also concerned about the increased traffic from all of the cars leaving a an already highly populated street. In sum, I do not think this area of Prospect can handle another high rise and I strongly oppose the plan of 1550. Is there anything I can formally do to oppose this beyond this email? Several people in my building are also concerned about this, so please let me know.
