Dear Milwaukee Common Council members,

This email is to convey our strong objections to high rise development on the Goll Mansion property.

We believe that such a project would have significant adverse impacts on our community:

1. Fire safety: adequate access for emergency services on the Goll property, adjacent properties, and other nearby properties on Prospect Avenue.
2. Traffic congestion and disruption, impacting quality of life, travel times and safety
3. Inadequate parking along Prospect and nearby streets.
4. Negative impact to the bluff and nearby green space
5. High likelihood of damage to, or destruction of, the historic Goll Mansion during the proposed move.
6. Lack of supporting engineering study demonstrating the adequacy of the Goll site for such a project.

We appreciate your thorough and critical assessment of this project, and of the concerns of our citizens in the area.
