AGREEMENT FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF SISTER CITIES RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE CITY OF MILWAUKEE (U.S.A.) AND DAEGU METROPOLITAN CITY (REPUBLIC OF SOUTH KOREA)

Whereas, The Sister City Program were deliberated by Milwaukee Sister Cities International[®] and by Daegu Global Urban Committee respectively to encourage greater friendship and understanding between the two cities; and

Whereas, In order to foster those goals, the people of Milwaukee and Daegu Metropolitan City in a gesture of friendship and goodwill, agree to collaborate for the mutual benefit of their communities by exploring economic, educational and cultural opportunities; and

Whereas, We agree to support and encourage opportunities for mutually beneficial practical exchanges in the fields of business, education, culture, health care and tourism; and to share other common interests to promote mutual understanding among our citizens; and

Whereas, The resolutions of establishing the sister cities were approved by Daegu Metropolitan Council on September 9, 2016 and by Milwaukee Common Council on March 28, 2017 respectively, and became effective;

Now Therefore, Milwaukee and Daegu Metropolitan City do hereby proclaim themselves Sister Cities, and declare their intent to abide by these guidelines according to their Sister Cities policies.
