## **Property**

910 W. HISTORIC MITCHELL ST. Mitchell Street Historic District **Description of work** The renovation of the Hills Building will include the installation of new signage at the

southeast corner of the building and a monument sign at the library portion of the parking lot along 9th Street.

One blade sign will be mounted between the second and third stories spelling out The Alexander Lofts. This sign will be 34 inches wide and 150 feet tall. The aluminum face will feature routed letters at the top and bottom, "The" and "Lofts". "Alexander" will have push through letters. The sign will be attached to the building by four brackets. See attached design.

A second blade sign will be located at the first story and identify the Mitchell Street Branch of the Milwaukee Public Library. It will be 3 feet wide and 5 feet 6 inches tall. The aluminum face will feature push through letters and a digital sign indicating when the library is closed or open. The sign will be attached to the building by two brackets.

The double sided monument sign is 10 feet tall, 4 feet wide and 10 inches thick. It will feature an aluminum face with push through letters. The foundation will consist of exposed concrete. A digital sign will be located at the top of the sign indicating closed or open.

All work is to be completed according to the designs submitted.










Flag mounted sign at southeast corner of the building
