Congratulations! This is notification that the sister city relationship between the City of Milwaukee and Daegu, South Korea is now official as a result of a sister city relationship agreement being sufficiently signed on September 20, 2017 during a signing ceremony in Daegu, South Korea. The sister city relationship is valid for five years from the date of the signed agreement and will expire on September 20, 2022.

Please note that an annual report on the relationship's progress must be submitted every year to the City of Milwaukee Sister City Committee within 30 days following the anniversary of the date on which Mayor Barrett signed the resolution establishing a sister city relationship. The anniversary date of the sister city relationship with the City of Daegu is April 6th. **Therefore, please submit the first annual report to our office regarding the sister city relationship by May 6, 2018.**

We look forward to maintaining this sister city relationship with you. The City of Milwaukee is a member of Sister Cities International and adheres to its policies and procedures in reviewing and maintaining relationships. We believe a limited number of such relationships are beneficial to cultural, economic, and educational growth and development for all involved.
