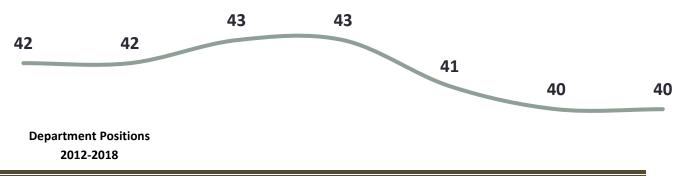


**Staffing Vacancies**

### Staffing Update

- Two staff members are eligible for retirement in 2017.
- 2 Municipal Court Clerk I positions have been defunded as part of a pilot project to see if the Court is able to function with a leaner staff.

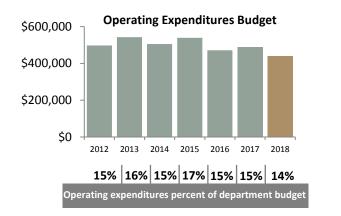

### Warrant Withdrawal Wednesday

During these events, judges assist people with setting payment plans, providing time to pay and alternative options to payment, while removing barriers of warrants and drivers' license suspensions.

3 WWW events were held in 2016, during which approximately 2,400 individuals were seen. 63 individuals were assigned community service in lieu of monetary payments.

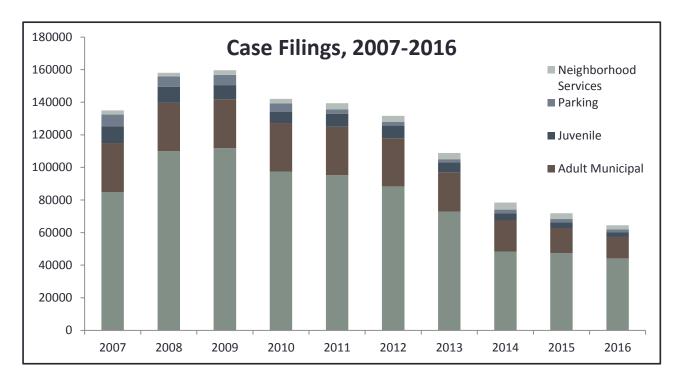
2 WWW events will be held in 2017 at off-site locations.

### **Night Court**

Evening court sessions were offered on 11 dates in 2016. 25 sessions were scheduled for 495 defendants, involving 730 cases. Approximately 73% of the scheduled defendants appeared in court.

#### **Building and Zoning Code Cases**

In 2016, there were 2,554 cases filed in Municipal Court by the Department of Neighborhood Services.
