Given the increased administrative and operational activities required by DNS under CCFN 170188 (including certifying contractors, maintaining a list of certified contractors, monitoring and tracking deconstruction activity, maintaining records for reuse/recycle and material chain of custody, labor/workforce/RPP tracking, documenting exemptions and appeals, placing and removing signs), DNS will need to fill a Program Assistant II position and a Building Constgruction Inspector position that are currently unfunded in the 2018 Proposed Budget.
