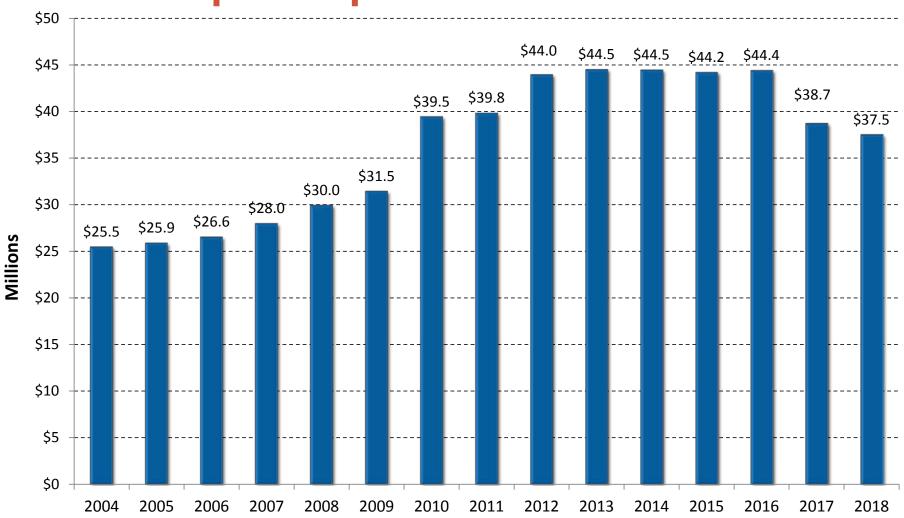

Sewer Maintenance Fund Capital Improvement Allocation



In 2010, \$15.5 million of Federal stimulus money was available for the Sewer capital program. In 2011, \$2.8 million of MMSD grant funds were budgeted for Infiltration and Inflow reduction projects.

Capital Budget Highlights

- Sewer Relay Program
 - 2018 proposed = 5 miles
 - Large diameter sewer replacement project reduces total mileage for 2017 and 2018
- I & I Reduction
 - 2018 proposed = 13 miles
- Water Quality Projects to meet TMDL requirements
 - \$1.5 City funds + \$664,000 in MMSD grant = \$2.2 million total
